



HISTORY

The Churches of Faith Incorporated was founded by Bishop Belva J. Williams, after many months of fasting and praying urged by spiritual inspiration. It was accepted by the Alpha and Omega Church body, of which Bishop J. Williams Pastor, establishing this church headquarters for the organization.

The Certificate of Incorporation of the Metaphysics Churches of Faith was issued on 19th day August 1954. Our Founder and First Bishop Belva Williams Fair built and grew the order with 10 or more churches based on the vision that God gave her, Today, we stand on that vision and continue to do the work as the Churches of Faith Inc. Bishop William entered transition in April, 1969 in the spirit of Bishop Williams we will continue to "Go Forth and bless the world".

In 1971 Bishop Chamble was consecrated and was elevated to Presiding Archbishop of The Churches of Faith Inc. In 2007 The Board of Directors requesting name change to The Churches of Faith Inc. This request was sent to N.C. Secretary of State and the U.S. Internal Revenue Service- both was approved. Bishop Chamble continued the mission "Go Forth and Bless the world and served his generation until he fell asleep on July 31, 2004. He was loved dearly and is missed by many. Bishop Chamble always encouraged the faithful to carry on the tradition and standards that we were upon. We continue to grow daily and add to the numbers of souls harvested for the master's service.

In 2005. John W. Huntley Jr. was consecrated and elevated to Presiding Bishop of The Churches of Faith Inc. The Churches continue to grow daily and add to the number of souls for Christ.

Bishop Huntley entered transition in April 2018. After Bishop Huntley transitioned, The Churches of Faith Inc. struggled because of lack of vision. Many of the fellowship churches broke away and The Churches of Faith was left with two member churches (Scared Hearts Churches of Faith Inc. and Alpha and Omega Church of Faith Inc.). Overseer Ruby Franklin Reed of Scared Hearts Churches of Faith Inc. and The Board of Directors continue to be faithful to the mission.

In the year 2019 Bishop Frank R. Lacey was appointed and consecrated by The Board of Directors of The Churches of Faith Inc. to Chief Apostle and Presiding Bishop. His vision for the Organization is to assist the fellowship in the area of Church and community development and to bring forth a Christian education program for youth and adults on every level.

Apostle Lacey has a tremendous passion for God's word coupled with a love for God's people. He has a contagious spirit of generosity that overflows throughout every facet of his ministry.
